Project Description

The property is near the headwaters of Noisette Creek, a tributary to the Cooper River and Charleston Harbor. The city of North Charleston will combine this property with others to create a passive park along Noisette Creek.

Compliance with Greenbelt Plan:

- Assists in meeting the goals of the Greenbelt Plan's system components in the following manner:
 - 3 acres toward meeting the goal of protecting 2,000 acres of urban greenbelt lands
- Meets the following components of the Greenbelt Plan's definition of greenbelts:
 - Passive greenspace
 - Lowcountry natural resources
- Meets four purposes of the Greenbelt Plan:
 - Preservation of natural resources
 - Protection of scenic landscapes
 - Outdoor access and recreation
 - Protection of public health, safety and welfare
- Addresses wishes of public by:
 - Providing passive greenspace, which is the most desired type of greenspace identified by citizens.
