This 4.29-acre property is located in an unincorporated area of Mount Pleasant that is under tremendous pressure for development. The proposed project is for a passive park that can be used for walking, jogging, nature observation and community gatherings

- Addresses wishes of public by:

 - Provides walking trails, which is one of the top three desired uses of greenspace identified by citizens.
- Citizens ranked conservation/preservation as their highest priority for greenspace in the East County area.
