Charleston County's Greenbelt Advisory Board Seeks Public Input

The Charleston County Greenbelt Advisory Board will meet Wednesday, June 15 at 3 p.m. Temporary chairman Arthur Ravenel, Jr. would like the public to attend the meeting to let the Board know what "greenbelts" are needed. The meeting will be located in the Council Committee Room on the second floor of the County's Public Services Building in North Charleston.

The Board was created by Charleston County Council to make recommendations on transportation sales tax expenditures for greenbelt projects. For the 2006 fiscal year, \$5.9 million has been budgeted for greenbelts.

The Public Services Building is located at 4045 Bridge View Drive. The meeting agenda includes a presentation by the S.C. Department of Natural Resources on its Heritage Trust land protection program. Please call 843-958-4006 for more information about Wednesday's meeting.
